

Smoking and Vaping/E-Cigarettes Policy

As per the Health Act 2006, smoking indoors is illegal in the UK. Students, staff and associates of inlingua Leeds must not smoke, vape or use any e-cigarettes inside any building owned or used by inlingua Leeds.

However, those who would like to smoke should leave the College building and smoke outdoors. At York House, the designated smoking areas are at the back of the building in the car park or at the front of the building. Students using these areas must use the ashtrays provided and not throw their cigarette butts onto the floor. Doing this in public spaces can lead to a fine, and is unsightly.

Students, staff or associates who smoke, vape or use any e-cigarettes inside will be fined £50 on the spot. Anyone caught littering with cigarettes will be fined £50 on the spot. Fines can be issued by any member of inlingua Leeds staff and will be payable within 5 days. Late fines may result in disciplinary action or increased fines, depending on the situation. The decision will be made by inlingua Leeds management and their decision is final.
