

Social Excursions/Activities Policy

inlingua Leeds wants all students to enjoy their time in the UK and to experience British culture. Throughout the year the school runs weekend and weekday social activities, including the Afternoon Clubs and events. These provide an opportunity for students to socialise with each other, practise their English, see places of interest and to try new things. Many of these activities are based around promoting Britain and British culture and values, to highlight our commitment as per our Anti-Radicalisation Policy.

These include (but are not limited to):

- College parties
- Afternoon Clubs
- College events
- Excursions
- University visits
- Open events

Some activities are funded by the college, but students pay for some activities. Activities and excursions are planned carefully and organised by our administrative staff, sometimes helped by extra members of staff (sometimes teachers) according to group numbers. Costs are made known in full to students via the promotional posters. Any extra costs (such as optional trips) are also included.

Events and parties in the school are held termly. Students are invited to join in and events are publicised through promotional material around the school and through staff. These events are run in English in order to encourage English communication and intercultural communication.

All activities and events organised by inlingua Leeds are inclusive of all students. No student or staff member can request that only certain student groups are permitted to join or attempt to discourage students from a certain group from coming along.

All inlingua Leeds activities are, unless otherwise stated, closed to non-students. In cases where non-students are allowed to join in, they must be over 18 years old and join in with the activity as per the expectations of inlingua Leeds.

Third party events

Are from a recognised organisation or company, not private events.

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- Will be conducted entirely in English.
- Fit the needs and interests of the majority of students.
- Are outside of the main course times.
- Are suitable for international students.

inlingua Leeds does not take any responsibility for these outside events and it is made clear in the publicity that these events are not part of inlingua Leeds. If a student has a complaint about a club or event, inlingua Leeds management will consider whether it will continue to advertise this event and the organisers will be contacted to resolve any issues.
