

Visa Policy

All students can check if they need a visa to come to study in the UK using this UK Government website: https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa

All students coming to inlingua Leeds must obey the visa regulations of the UK. These regulations will change depending on their country of origin, their status, the amount of time they want to stay and other factors. Each student is responsible for finding the correct information that they need before they try to come to our College. inlingua Leeds cannot take responsibility for any rejected visas. inlingua Leeds can only help with visas for inlingua Leeds students.

Students must give full and accurate information to inlingua Leeds at all times during the application process, and this is especially key with students requiring a visa. If a student sends incorrect or incomplete information, it is likely that inlingua Leeds will not be able to process their application or the visa will be rejected. Students may be recommended to use a partner agency who can help with the visa application. This is only a suggestion and students who do not choose to use that service will not be penalised in any way.

Short term study visas

inlingua Leeds can only help by providing proof of study for a Short-Term Study visa.

Students must follow all of the conditions of their Short-Term Study visa at all times during their stay in the UK.

Standard Visitor visa

Students can study at inlingua Leeds for a maximum of 30 days (6 week booking) while they are in the UK on a Standard Visitor visa. Study should not be a main reason they are in the UK.
