Students at inlingua Leeds agree to consent to all of inlingua Leeds rules and policies and are provided with a complete list of inlingua Leeds policies when they start their booking.

These rules are displayed around inlingua Leeds.

- 1. You must **come to every class**. If you are ill or cannot come to class, you must call the college before 9.15. If you are sponsored, we will tell your sponsor if you are absent.
- 2. You must **be on time for all classes and activities**. In the UK, being late is disrespectful and rude. If you are late, please call the college before your class starts.
- 3. You must **respect your classmates and your teacher**. Listen to them and be kind to them.
- 4. You must **do all class work and homework** given to you by your teacher. If you cannot do the work, please talk to your teacher and they can help you.
- 5. You must **bring your book, a notebook and a pen** with you every day. If you forget these a lot, you will be asked to pay for the photocopies of the course book (10p per page). You can buy notebooks and pens at reception.
- 6. You must **respect the rules of inlingua Leeds**. You can find these in our policies and you can ask us if you have any questions.
- 7. You must **respect the college building**. Keep the college, classrooms, student areas, kitchens and bathrooms clean and tidy.
- 8. You must respect the rules of the UK.
- 9. You must **complete all payments** on time.
